#### TRAIN / TUBE / BUS

A wide choice of train, tube and bus route options are located at Stratford and Stratford International stations, which lie a 20 minute walk away from the Stadium

### Stratford station is served by

- Docklands Light Railway (DLR)
- London Underground Jubilee and Central lines
- National Rail services operated by Greater Anglia and c2c
- London Overground services

## Stratford International station is served by

- Docklands Light Railway (DLR)
- Southeastern High Speed 1 services

#### **BUS**

All TfL main bus routes are now wheelchair accessible. The main bus stops close to the Stadium are located on Carpenters Road and Wick Lane. Further information is available through www.tfl.gov.uk.

#### **CAR**

Accessible drop-off location – visitors can use Westfield Stratford drop-off areas, located at the entrance of each car park.

#### **ACCESSIBLE PARKING INFORMATION**

A limited amount of parking for Blue Badge holders is available at the Stadium, but must be booked in advance.

#### **VENUE INFORMATION**

If you have a ticket for accessible seating, you can use any entrance. All turnstile blocks have Disabled Access doors. The main concourses are level and step free, and there are accessible lifts spread over all levels.

#### **QUEUING**

The Stadium has several Disabled Access Dedicated Doors which should prevent unnecessary wait.

Talk to a member of staff at the Stadium entrance if you have a disability that means you cannot queue, and they will arrange a priority entry for you as soon as the stadium opens.

#### Payment


A state of the art EPOS system exists so all concessions can accept card payment.

Flags more than 250cm in size at their widest or longest section will not be allowed and flagpoles greater than 1m in length and 1cm in diameter will not allowed.

Permission must be sought in advance from the Stadium to arrange use of the very large supporter flags that are designed to be passed over people's heads. In such cases the flag must be flame retardant and the organiser bringing the flag into the Stadium will need to provide the appropriate H&S certification.

In addition, please note that any articles that could potentially be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety are strictly prohibited.

#### **SMOKING**

Smoking inside London Stadium is strictly forbidden and will result in ejection from the Stadium. The use of e-cigarettes is also forbidden within the Stadium.
